
Our Mission

What is GIST?

Gastrointestinal stromal tumors (GIST), usually found in the gastrointestinal tract, belong to a rare group of cancers called soft-tissue sarcomas. Although GIST is often spoken of in the singular, it is actually a family of cancers that encompasses adult, pediatric, and familial (hereditary) forms.

Patient Support

Education & Training Programs

Our initiatives include:

LRG GIST Patient Registry

With over 2800 records from our global GIST community, our registry tracks patients across institutions, offering centralized record-keeping and personalized support. Our rigorous quality control ensures that this valuable data is an asset for research criteria, guaranteeing that the patient voice is present at every stage of the process.

GIST Collaborative Tissue Bank

This bank holds 800+ tissue samples that are tied to clinical data facilitating the understanding and the acceleration of GIST research.

Virtual Tumor Boards

In this forum, specialists from around the world review complex clinical cases in order to provide an action plan for each patient.

Global Surveillance Team

A network of global physicians and researchers who collaborate regularly on topics related to patient survival.
